EVENT Format (Main Draw):

- 16 teams of four players and one coach:
 - 8 teams by National ranking
 - 4 teams out of Province teams (ACE WC)
 - 4 teams from Qualification
- Four boxes of four teams play compass team format, two rounds per team.
Boxes set up by OTA. Teams from the same Academy/Club will be placed in different boxes.
- All team matches three rotations:
First rotation - two doubles matches, second rotation - #3 and # 4 singles, third rotation - #2 and #1 singles
- Teams are ranked 1 through 4 in box.
#1 ranked team in each box makes it to Championship flight #1, same for #2, #3, #4
